Many people went to view the annular solar eclipse on June 21, 2020 in Taiwan. It is said if you miss this chance, you will have to wait for another 195 years to see the next

one. Therefore, many people traveled to southern part of Taiwan to see this magical phenomenon. Streets and parks are crowded with people in Chiayi and Tainan. The eclipse started at 2:49pm and ended at 5:25pm. The complete “ring of fire” took place for less than a minute at 4:14, when 99 percent of the sun’s surface was blocked by the moon. However, it is harmful to view the sun directly without proper eye protection. Some people are reported to have vision problems after looking directly into the sun. Therefore, never watch the sun with your naked eyes. Be sure to use eclipse glasses or a Sun filter; sunglasses cannot provide effective protection.
